## NOTICE OF COMMISSIONERS COURT MEETING

Notice is hereby given that on Monday, May 22, 2017, the Commissioners Court of Zavala County will hold their regular meeting at 10:00 a.m. at Commissioners Court room, 200 E. Uvalde St. Ste.9, Crystal City, Texas.

The subjects to be discussed are listed on the agenda(s), which are attached to and made a part of this notice.

If during the course of the meeting covered by this notice, the Commissioners Court should determine that a closed or executive meeting or session of the Commissioners Court is required, then such closed or executive meeting or session as authorized by the Texas Open Meetings Act, Texas Government Code Section 51.001 et. Seq., will be held by the Commissioners Court at the date, hour, and place given in this notice or as soon after the commencement of the meeting covered by this notice as the Commissioners Court may conveniently meet in such closed or executive meeting or session concerning any and all purposes permitted by the Act, including, but not limited to the following sections and purposes:

### **Texas Government Code Section:**

- 551.071 For the purpose of a private consultation with the Commissioners Court’s attorney on any or all subjects or matter authorized by law.
- 551.072 For the deliberation regarding real property.
- 551.074 For the purpose of considering the appointment, employment, evaluation, reassignment, duties, discipline or dismissal of a public officer or employee, to hear complaints or charges against a public officer or employee.


Should any final action, final decision, or vote be required in the opinion of the Commissioners Court with regard to any matter considered in such closed or executive meeting or session, then the final action decision, or final vote shall be either

- (a) in the open meeting covered by the Notice upon the reconvening of the public meeting; or
- (b) at the subsequent public meeting of the Commissioners Court upon notice thereof; as the Commissioners Court shall determine.



5. request by Community Council of South Central Texas to consider approval by proclaiming the month of May as Community Action partnership month;
6. consider offer for the County of Zavala to purchase lots located next to the Popeye walking trail;
7. request by father Gerardo Silos for inmates to do landscaping at the Catholic Church grounds;
8. consider approving the purchase of a notary seal for the Department of Public Safety personnel;
9. consider for approval to advertise for bids on Health Insurance for Zavala County;
10. consider paying for repair of water truck;
11. consider declaring county equipment and furniture as surplus;
12. consider approving budget amendment for Precinct #4;
13. consider approving budget amendment for Department of Public Safety;
14. consider approving budget amendment for Utility Department;
15. report by attorney Mr. Paul Fletcher regarding Eminent Domain litigations;
16. close session: The Commissioners Court will hold a closed session under the Texas Government Code Legal Section -551.071 of the Open Meeting Act, regarding private consultation with attorney;
17. open session: Action if any on item no. 15 and 16 above;
18. report by Fisher Heck Architects regarding new courthouse;
19. consider approving bills and requisitions;
20. commissioner request for future agenda items  
(No action or discussion may occur during this agenda item); and
21. adjourn.

If during the course of the meeting, discussion of any item on the agenda should be held in a closed meeting, the Board will conduct a closed meeting in accordance with the Texas Open Meetings Act, Government Code, Chapter 551, Subchapters D and E, including consultation with counsel under section 551.071 and certain personnel matters under section 551.074. Before any closed meeting is convened, the presiding officer will publicly identify the Section or Sections of the Act authorizing the closed meeting. All final votes, actions, or decisions will be taken in open meeting.
