PUBLIC SAFETY PROBATION SERVICES INDIGENT DEFENSE

Including enforcing state laws, and providing housing and care for state prisoners prior to transfer to the state.

JUSTICE

Housing 1,800 courts in the state system, including 13 of 14 regional courts of appeal and 465 district courts.

And in addition, funding and running state district courts, constitutional county courts, county courts at law and justice of the peace courts.





REGISTRATIONS

Collecting and remitting state fines and fees (including more than \$1.4 billion in motor vehicle registrations).

VETERANS SERVICES

Providing facilities and coordinated access and assistance.



ELECTIONS

Registering voters and maintaining more than **5,200 voting precincts** and reporting all election results to the state.



VITAL RECORDS KEEPING

Archiving vital records about Texans, their businesses and property ownership, court proceedings and more.
